Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Webster County Health Unit will be at your child's school to give the Tdap and Meningococcal (ACWY) vaccines to students who are entering 8th grade. Tdap vaccine protects against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis. Meningococcal disease is a serious bacterial illness that can lead to Meningitis. Both vaccines are **REQUIRED** by the State of Missouri for all 8th grade students. There will be no cost to you for these vaccines.

The vaccines will be given at your child's school on **Friday March 7th**.

If you would like for your child to receive these vaccines at school, please register them online at: <https://patients.vaxcare.com/registration>. Use Access Code: **MO26208**. Choose your child's school to begin registration. **The deadline for online registration is March 3rd**. Contact the school nurse if you are unable to register online.

If you have questions regarding the Tdap or Meningococcal vaccine, please call the Webster County Health Unit.
